RESPONSIBILITIES AND QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates for this position should have an earned doctorate or ABD with expected completion before September, 2010. Responsibilities include teaching at the doctoral level in the Special Education Doctoral Program and at the undergraduate and/or master's levels. Candidates for this position should have a strong background in research methodologies, particularly as it applies to the field of special education. Preference will be given, but not limited, to candidates who have content expertise in one or more of the following: secondary special education, low incidence disabilities, literacy education, assessment, and/or effective inclusion for diverse populations. Direct experience teaching students with disabilities and inclusive practices is desirable. In addition, candidates will have the opportunity to work with faculty in programs at the global/international and local school/community-based levels as well as to engage in curriculum and professional development activities for teachers in local school districts. Additional responsibilities include mentoring doctoral candidates and advising students. Candidates should hold a doctoral degree in special education or a related field. School-based experience and special education certification is required.
