Doctoral Fellowships in Education Southern Methodist University Dallas, Texas

SMU offers fellowships leading to a Ph.D. in education. Led by a nationally recognized faculty, the doctoral program includes 4 broad specialty areas: Instructional Design; Special Populations; Research Methods & Assessment; and Literacy, Math, or Science. Each area contains several concentrations. The Core Research curriculum includes seminars in research paradigms and design, a quantitative statistics series, advanced assessment methods, and mixed research methods. Funded projects provide opportunities for field research. Fellowship positions are limited and depend on grant funding, but all include tuition and stipends. Master's-level degree and professional experience required. Competitive application processing will begin on February 15 and end on May 1.
