### Goals

1. Communicate to the TED Board essential information related to CEC's activities, policies, strategic plan, and other items of interest and relevance to TED.
2. Convey from TED Board to RA the division's views on issues that have been raised, initiatives for discussion, concerns related to policies and strategic planning, and other information as requested.
3. Represent TED at RA meetings and in RA e-Community discussions.

### Accomplishments:

1. Participated in the RA orientation meeting and reviewed all required RA documents and guidelines.

### Discussion/Action Items:

1. The RA will meet in April at the CEC Convention. The primary discussion item on the agenda is the CEC 2009-2011 Strategic Plan. Input from the TED board is requested regarding proposed goals, issue statements and outcomes related to the strategic plan. Discussion will focus on responses to the following questions:
  - a. Are the goals, taken as a whole, consistent with our values, mission and vision statement?
  - b. Given the three-year time frame of the CEC Strategic Plan, are the most critical and strategic external and internal issues for the Council addressed? Why or Why not?
  - c. How can the CEC Strategic Plan support and facilitate Units in meeting the needs of their members?
  - d. Are there other outcomes in the CEC strategic plan that particularly address unit and affiliate concerns and that should be considered in terms of their implementation at the state, provincial or division level?
  - e. What would success look like for the strategic plan? What might key success indicators or measures be for each of the goals?
